

## **Northern Nova United Soccer Club Spectator Code of Conduct**

The aim of the NNU Code of Conduct is to promote a safe, positive and fun soccer environment for everyone. NNU is committed to upholding the Code of Conduct for its players, volunteer coaches and spectators. In cases where players or coaches do not follow the principles and rules of the Code of Conduct, NNU will continue to follow established club and league disciplinary procedures.

In cases where spectators do not follow the principles and rules of the Code of Conduct, NNU has adopted the following club disciplinary procedures, effective January 2009:

### **First occurrence**

Any person who displays behavior contrary to the Code of Conduct will be issued a verbal or written warning by the coach, manager or a representative of the NNU Board of Directors.

### **Second occurrence**

Any person who continues to display such behavior will be suspended from all club activities for a period of time determined by the NNU Board of Directors.

### **Third occurrence**

Any person who displays such behavior on a third occasion will be banned from all club activities indefinitely.

In cases of particularly serious incidents, the NNU Board of Directors may impose immediate suspensions or bans from club activities. The NNU Board of Directors may also revoke the club registration for players associated with any person who fails to comply with disciplinary measures taken by the club.

NNU urges everyone involved in club activities to work together in promoting a safe, positive and fun soccer environment. Upholding our Code of Conduct is a shared responsibility.
